1. Purpose. To prescribe the number of initial Naval Reserve Officers' Training Corps (NROTC) Navy option offers necessary for Continuous National Selection Board (CNSB) review to attain NROTC Navy option enrollment targets for academic year 2013-2014. Naval Service Training Command's (NSTC) production management guidance for granting four-year NROTC scholarships to include Immediate Scholarship Reservations (ISR); Alternative Scholarship Reservations (ASR); Minority Serving Institution Scholarship Reservations (MSISR); Cyber Option Scholarship Reservations (COSR); Language, Regional Expertise, and Culture Awareness (LREC) scholarships), and side-load scholarships ensures NROTC officer production meets officer accession requirements established in reference (a).

2. Background.

a. This NSTC Notice supersedes NROTC Year Group 2015 (YG15) and 2016 (YG16) Navy option side-load numbers prescribed in reference (b).

b. Reference (c) directs two NROTC Cyber Warfare Engineers be accessed in Year Group 2014 (YG14).

c. Reference (d) directs CNSB members to identify NROTC applicants who possess the greatest potential for success both academically and as naval officers. It also directs that the CNSB will validate ISR NROTC scholarship offers made by Naval Recruiting Command. Authorized number of scholarship offers is listed in Table A

d. Reference (e) directs NSTC Officer Development (OD) to assign 85% of the incoming NROTC Navy Option Scholarship freshmen as technical academic majors with the goal of a minimum of 65% graduates completing a technical degree program before receiving a Navy commission.

e. Reference (f) provides procedural guidance to facilitate achieving the annual requirement of commissioning 20 NROTC LREC program officers.

f. Reference (g) allocates 110 of the total NROTC academic year scholarship offers for ASR NROTC scholarships.

g. Reference (h) provides procedural guidance for granting MSISR NROTC scholarships.

3. Action

a. Initial Scholarship Offers and Enrolls. NSTC OD shall attain YG17 NROTC Navy option scholarship offer numbers by scholarship type as prescribed in Table A with the goal of meeting projected Table A enrollment numbers. The CNSB will review all scholarship types.

(1) CNSB members shall ensure that not less than 85% of all NROTC Navy option scholarship offers are to applicants who intend on enrolling in a Tier 1 or Tier 2 academic major.

(2) Commander, NSTC will designate approximately 170 4-Year NROTC Navy option scholarships as MSISR scholarships. Professors of Naval Science (PNS) from each unit may nominate applicants interested in attending Historically Black Colleges and Universities, Minority Institutions, and High Hispanic Enrollment Institutions.

b. Side-load Process. This notice modifies sections 3-5, 3-7, 3-10, and 3-13 of reference (i) by limiting the total number of National Two-Year, OD Controlled, Tweeddale and Leadership scholarships to the number authorized by NROTC year group in Table B, effective on the date of the notice.

(1) PNS's shall recruit and recommend students for side-load scholarships. NSTC OD will convene a panel, as required, to review side-load scholarships with preference provided to students enrolled in academic majors as outlined in references (e) and (f). Panels will consist of no fewer than three officers or federal civilians. NSTC OD shall forward the panel results to CNSTC or a designee for review. Once approved/disapproved, CNSTC or a designee will return the results to the PNS for appropriate action.


(2) NSTC N7, in coordination with NSTC OD, shall review the scholarship allocations in Table B each semester to ensure appropriate offers are made based on current student enrollments and latest production requirements.
